Vote NO on Props 6 & 8

to protect our youth, families,
and communities!

NO on 6 – All youth deserve resources and opportunities, NOT laws that put more youth in prison.

Prop 6 moves millions of dollars away from schools and into prisons. Californians already spend four times as much money per prisoner as we do per public school student, even though quality education, healthcare, and good jobs are necessary for our communities to reduce crime. Low-income youth, youth of color, and immigrant youth are most likely to be harmed by this proposition. Vote NO on Prop 6 because *all* youth deserve resources and opportunities.

NO on 8 – All our families, no matter what they look like, need respect and support, NOT laws that take away our right to be a family.

Prop 8 would change California's Constitution to define marriage as only between a man and a woman. Everyone deserves the right to marry and create a family with the people they love – single parents, extended families, immigrant families and families with two moms or dads. Vote NO on Prop 8 because *all* families deserve equal rights, respect and support.
